Fire Marshall Course



Seri Mulia Sarjana School and Seri Mulia Sarjana International School Teachers and Staff benefited from fire safety training conducted by the Fire and Rescue, Headquarters Team held in Bomba, Old Airport last 7 June to 9 June 2010. The training allowed them to command greater responsibility in the event of fire. Among the participants from SMSIS were Teachers Chong,

Joel E, Olivia, Marlowe, Sarina, Neneng and Winnie. Teacher Sarina turned out to be the best female participant. The core objective of this course is to provide teachers and staff of responsibility with specific information, skills and knowledge, enabling them to perform the duties of a fire marshal for the safety of the children and the institution itself. The course



tailored to the specific needs of exceptionally well qualified fire safety experts. They covered topics such as Fire safety law and risk assessment principles, routine and emergency duties of a fire marshal, how to use and choose the correct fire extinguisher, what to do when you discover a fire - raising the alarm and contacting the



fire department, evacuation principles/techniques and the management of assembly points, how to handle typical human behaviour in hazardous situations and a lot more.

It was indeed a tough 3-day training. This workshop allows the teachers and staff the person responsible for

the premises, to act as a controlling figurehead in the event of a fire. In conclusion, this is a crucial workshop as it can help save lives....
